RESOLUTION ON THE DESIGNATION OF NOMINATED ELECTRICITY MARKET OPERATOR

15 December 2015 No O3-649

Vilnius

Abiding by Articles 4 and 6 of Commission Regulation (EU) 2015/1222 of 24 July 2015 establishing a guideline on capacity allocation and congestion management (hereinafter – Regulation), Article 63 and Article 64, Paragraph 1 of the Law on Electricity of the Republic of Lithuania, Article 9 of the Resolution No 740 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania as of 8 July 2009 on the Lithuanian electricity market development plan, with regard to the Article 37, Paragraph i of the Directive 2009/72/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 July 2009 concerning common rules for the internal market in electricity and repealing Directive 2003/54/EC, Baltic Energy Market Interconnection Plan, agreed on 19 June 2009 and renewed on 8 June 2015 by the European Commission, the Kingdom of Denmark, the Federal Republic of Germany, the Republic of Estonia, the Republic of Latvia, the Republic of Lithuania, the Republic of Poland, the Republic of Finland and the Kingdom of Sweden, Agreement No. SUT-96-12 between LITGRID AB and Nord Pool Spot AS (hereinafter – NPS) as of 26 March 2012 on power exchange operation in the Republic of Lithuania, Official Letters by NPS – Ref. No R1-8440 as of 15 September 2015, Ref. No R1-10590 as of 30 November 2015, Ref. No R1-10930 as of 11 December 2015 and Designation Document No O5-458 of the Electricity Division of the Gas and Electricity Department of the National Commission for Energy Control and Prices (hereinafter – the „NCC“) as of 14 December 2015 regarding the designation of nominated electricity market operator, the NCC has resolved as follows:

1. To state that NPS activity complies with the provisions of Article 6 of the Regulation and it may be designated as the nominated electricity market operator in the Lithuanian electricity trade zone for four years after the entry in to force this Resolution, i. e. by 15 December 2019.

2. To inform the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) about the adoption of this Resolution.

3. In the cases of changed circumstances, due to which the implementation of the requirements on NPS activities set forth in Article 6 of the Regulation cannot be ensured, to obligate NPS to inform the Commission no later than within 5 business days from the date of occurrence of these changed circumstances.

The complaints regarding this Resolution may be filed according to the procedure and conditions set for by the Law on Proceedings of Administrative Cases of the Republic of Lithuania.
